When I opened the box, all I could say was, "Wow!" I'm not sure what I was expecting but I couldn't believe the amount of products they sent me. So first of all, thank you so much Kernel Season's!



Since I don't have a popcorn maker, I opted to follow the stove-top directions. I was afraid that it wouldn't turn out as well but I was wrong. It was delicious and so easy to make. I just put some oil into a pot and put a few kernels in to gauge the temperature. Once they popped, I threw in the rest of the kernels and covered it. I would suggest you use a glass lid so that everyone can watch the fun. In a few minutes, they were done.
